

**1. Back Ground & Executive Summary-**

Government of India has launched Pradhan Mantri Matasya Sampada Yojana (2020-21 to 2024-25) with an objective to address critical gaps in fish production and productivity, technology, post-harvest infrastructure and management, modernization and strengthening of value chain, traceability, establishing a robust fisheries management framework and fishers'welfare. It is a scheme envisages to add 70 lakh tonnes of additional fish production in next 5 years all over India. It will increase fish production by around 40%, increase per hectare water area productivity upto 5-6 tonnes of fish per hectare per year. This will create conducive environment for private sector participation, ease of doing business, innovations and innovative projects, infusing new technologies like RAS (Re-circulatory Aquaculture System), Biofloc Culture System with focussed fisheries development in aspirational districts. It is also focussed to minimise the post-harvest losses.

a) Directorate of Fisheries, Jharkhand, Ranchi is submitting SLAMC approved proposal of Rs 396.6979 Crores in which CSS- Beneficiary Oriented is of Rs. 239.88 Crores and CSS- Non Beneficiary Oriented is of Rs. 156.8179 Crores for FY 2023-24. Administrative Expenses @ 2.5% of Central Share which is to be divided among GoI, NFDB and the State comes to Rs 447.146 lakh which is not included in demanded Central Share.

Subsidy component for the general category is 40% and for SC/ST/Women is 60%. The proposal has been prepared according to the proposals submitted by Districts Fisheries Officers as approved by DLCs.



## **2. Jharkhand at a Glance-**

### **2.1 General profile – Resources and population of fishers:**

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Jharkhand is predominantly an agriculture state. The major dependence of farming and its allied activities on rainfall has resulted in a meagre income from the small holdings of the community and has constrained the development of rural areas. The fisheries is an integral part of rural households more so, for the traditional fishermen whose livelihood is inseparably linked with fishing. An estimated 1.65 lakh fishermen in the state traditionally depend on fisheries and the activity provides secondary source of income and employment to all these rural households.

With over 75% of its 4.01 crores population (projected population of the state in FY 2022-23) depending on meat, mainly fresh fish, it is almost a staple food. The very large fish eating population comprising a wide range of ethnic groups and clans in tribal areas forms 70% of the population. With such a huge demand, the per capita fish consumption is 11.43 kg/year and the per capita availability of fish is low compared to the national average.

The existing demand for fish in the state is partly met through supplies from outside as the internal production is not adequate to meet the demand. On the other hand, fishes produced through cage culture in reservoirs are often sent to neighbouring states like Bihar, West Bengal and Orissa. The state has a large number of vast and diverse water bodies, developed for multiple purposes supplementing and complementing agriculture and allied activities. The state is blessed with sizeable water spread area in the form of rivers (1800 Kms), reservoirs (436 nos. ranging 20ha. to 16000 ha. with a total area around 145426 ha.), tanks (87202 ha.) and a good number of check dams, dobha and other water bodies viz., Ahars, coal pits, stone quarries etc. As large area is still underutilized, these resources thus have an immense potential for development of fisheries and aquaculture.

As for the type of water bodies in use, it is the tanks and reservoirs that form the major focus of fisheries development in Jharkhand. A significant number of water bodies are mainly rain water harvesting tanks accounting for more than one lakh. Of them, over 85% of the tanks with about 80% share in the total water spread area are in the private sector.

The fisheries sector in Jharkhand has been witnessing a phenomenal growth over the last decade with fish production growing more than three times to reach from 0.70 lakh MT in 2009-10 to **2.80 lakh MT in 2022-23**.

Most of the credit goes to the hard working fishers and technological support from GoJ in introducing new schemes like Cage culture in reservoirs, RAS, Pen/RFF culture and Ornamental Fisheries.

The present availability of fish per capita per year is 8.15 kg in year 2019-20 (with a presumption of 70% fish eating population) and the projected availability with the help of PMMSY (FY 2024-25) is 12.41 kg per capita per year, keeping in mind the exponential growth of population also.

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With such prospects ahead, the state has an ambitious plan to reach productivity level of over 5000 kg/ha in managed tanks as against the present average fish production is around 2150 kg /ha /year (National average: 2900 kgs). In the case of reservoirs, which are grossly underutilized, the state has been making concerted efforts through continuous stocking of fingerlings and promoting organized fishing, introduction of Cage culture in most of the suitable reservoirs and Pen/RFF culture of fish in reservoirs. This has been amply rewarded with fish catch in reservoirs.

With an annual production of 2.80 lakh MT of fish in 2022-23, the contribution of fisheries sector in total GSDP (Gross State Domestic Product) of the state at current prices is Rs. 371075.87 Crores.

Fisheries has always been a priority sector in the Department of Agriculture, Animal Husbandry & Cooperative. The Government aims at increasing fish production and productivity by providing backward and forward linkages, enhancing livelihoods of fishers, achieving self-sufficiency in production of fish seed, ensuring availability of fish to the consumers at an affordable price and in hygienic condition by improving the marketing infrastructure, and implementing welfare programs. Fisheries is one of the fast growing sectors generating income and employment in the State and, as well as contributing a lot to the State GSDP.

## 2.2 Schemes of Directorate of Fisheries:

The Directorate of Fisheries under Agriculture, Animal Husbandry & Cooperative Department is the prime agency behind holistic development of fisheries sector with the following fisheries developmental, welfare and extension programs or schemes. The department has implemented various schemes with an outlay of Rs.182.52 crores under State Plan. Further financial assistance from NFDB and GOI are under active consideration.

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## **Sharing of Funds between Centre/State and Beneficiaries:**

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**PMMSY will be implemented with the following funding pattern and share**

### **(A) Central Sector Scheme (CS)**

A.1 The entire project/unit cost will be borne by the Central Government (ie, 100% Central funding)

A.2 Whenever direct beneficiary oriented ie. Individual /group activities are undertaken by the entities of central government including NFDB, the central assistance will be upto 40% of the unit/project cost for General category and 60% for SC/ST/women category.

### **(B) Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS)**

#### **B.1 Non- Beneficiary Oriented Scheme**

The entire project/unit cost will be shared between Centre and State as detailed below- Jharkhand- 60% Central share

40% State share

#### **B.2 Beneficiary Oriented Scheme**

The government financial assistance of both Centre and State together will be limited to 40% of the project cost/unit cost for General Category and 60% for SC/ST/Women. The subsidy pattern for large RAS (Unit cost Rs. 50.00 lakh) has been decreased to 20% for General category & 25% of unit cost for SC/ST/Women from existing 40% and 60 % respectively( As per letter No. of 117012-3/2020-FY dated 12 December 2022 of Department of Fisheries, GOI). This assistance would be shared between centre and state on 60:40 ratio.

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### **Implementation Strategy:**

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- The Scheme will be implemented by Department of Agriculture, Animal Husbandry and Co-operative through the Directorate of Fisheries, Jharkhand.
- The End implementing Agencies would be the District Fisheries Offices of all the 24 districts of the State.
- All the applications are being processed in the respective districts.
- Selection of beneficiaries will be done by DLC duly constituted in each district by Govt. notification and the Deputy Commissioner of the district is chairman of DLC.
- The compiled recommendations of DLCs will be placed before SLAMC for its consent. A copy of the approved projects by SLAMC will be sent to NFDB and DoF, GoI.
- After proper budget provisions the scheme will be sanctioned after proper approval of the sanctioning authority.


#### कार्यवाही सं0 01 :- गत बैठक की संपुष्टि।

PMMSY योजनान्तर्गत गठित राज्य स्तरीय अनुमोदन एवं अनुश्रवण समिति (State Level Approval & Monitoring Committee-SLAMC) की दिनांक 31.05.2022 को सम्पन्न बैठक की कार्यवाही संपुष्ट की गई।

निदेशक मत्स्य-सह-सदस्य सचिव द्वारा बैठक में उपस्थित सभी पदाधिकारियों का स्वागत करते हुए प्रधानमंत्री मत्स्य सम्पदा योजना के बारे में प्रारंभिक जानकारियाँ दी गई। प्रथम चरण में यह योजना वित्तीय वर्ष 2020–21 से 2024–25 अर्थात् 5 वर्षों के लिए लागू की गई है।

वित्तीय वर्ष 2022–23 के लिए SLAMC की अनुशंसा उपरांत पत्रांक 974 दिनांक 15.06.2022 द्वारा भारत सरकार को प्रेषित प्रस्ताव के क्रम में मत्स्य पालन, पशुपालन एवं डेयरी मंत्रालय, भारत सरकार के पत्रांक j-01011/1/2020-Fy दिनांक 11.08.2022 द्वारा 83.522 करोड़ रु0 मात्र का प्रशासनिक अनुमोदन प्रदान किया गया है जिसमें केन्द्रांश 29.00736 करोड़ रु0 है। इसके विरुद्ध 7.2518 करोड़ रु0 मात्र प्रथम किस्त के रूप में विमुक्त हैं।

अब तक भारत सरकार एवं राज्य सरकार के शेयर को मिलाकर अनुदान की कुल राशि मो0 169.54 करोड़ (केन्द्रांश-101.76 एवं राज्यांश- 67.78 करोड़) रु0 की स्वीकृति प्रदान की गई है, जिसके विरुद्ध अब तक कुले मो0 93.93 करोड़ रु0 (केन्द्रांश-56.36 एवं राज्यांश- 37.57 करोड़) रु0 विमुक्त की गई है। जिसके विरुद्ध अब तक मो0 57 करोड़ रु0 व्यय किया जा चुका है।



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सचिव महोदय द्वारा निदेशित किया गया कि यथाशीघ्र 75 प्रतिशत राशि व्यय की जाय एवं उपयोगिता प्रमाण पत्र भारत सरकार को भेजते हुए राशि विमुक्त करने का अनुरोध किया जाय।

### कार्यवाही सं 02 :— वित्तीय वर्ष 2023–24 के कार्ययोजना पर विचार

मत्स्य पालन, पशुपालन एवं गव्य विकास मंत्रालय, भारत सरकार के पत्रांक J-117012/1/2020-Fy (E-15991) दिनांक 05.04.2023 द्वारा चालू वित्तीय वर्ष 2023–24 के लिए सभी प्रदेशों के लिए प्रधानमंत्री मत्स्य सम्पदा योजना का प्रशासनिक अनुमोदन निर्गत किया गया है। साथ ही पत्रांक J-117012/1/2020-Fy (E-15991) दिनांक 01.05.2023 द्वारा वित्तीय वर्ष 2023–24 के लिये केन्द्रांश मद में मो 13.00 करोड़ रु० की राशि कर्णाकित है साथ ही भारत सरकार द्वारा यह भी अंकित किया गया है कि योजनाओं के क्रियान्वयन में गति एवं सफलता प्राप्त होने से राज्य का allocation बढ़ाया जा सकता है।

योजनाओं एवं लाभुकों का चम्मन जिला स्तर पर, जिले के उपायुक्त की अध्यक्षता में गठित “जिला स्तरीय समिति” द्वारा होता है। वित्तीय वर्ष 2023–24 के लिए जिला स्तरीय समिति से अनुमोदित योजनाओं (Beneficiary Orientated Components) को राज्य स्तरीय अनुमोदन एवं अनुश्रवण समिति (State Level Approval & Monitoring Committee-SLAMC) के विचारार्थ रखा गया।

निदेशक मत्स्य द्वारा कमिटि को बताया गया कि प्रधानमंत्री मत्स्य सम्पदा योजना में लाभुकों को 40% से 60% तक अपना अंशदान लगाना होता है। हितधारकों की वित्तीय स्थिति को देखते हुए तथा इस योजना को गति देने हेतु राज्य सरकार द्वारा सैद्धान्तिक रूप से स्टेट टॉपअप (राज्य योजना से लाभुकों को अतिरिक्त सहायता) की योजना की स्वीकृति प्रदान की गई है।



निदेशक मत्स्य द्वारा वित्तीय वर्ष 2020–21, 2021–22 तथा 2022–23 में भारत सरकार द्वारा स्वीकृत परियोजनाओं के विरुद्ध भौतिक प्रगति की प्रस्तुति भी SLAMC के समक्ष रखी गई।

वित्तीय वर्ष 2023–24 की प्रस्तावित योजनाओं (अनुलग्नक 1) पर विस्तृत विचार विमर्श के उपरांत निम्न शर्तों के साथ अनुमोदन/अनुशंसित की गई—

1. योजनाओं का लाभुक चयन पारदर्शी तरीके से हो तथा ज्यादा संख्या में लाभुक आच्छादित हो।
2. प्रधानमंत्री मत्स्य सम्पदा योजना के दिशानिर्देशों का अनुपालन करने का निदेश सचिव महोदय द्वारा दिया गया।
3. जिला स्तरीय समिति से अनुमोदित बड़ी योजनाओं का डी० पी० आर०, भूमि की उपलब्धता, अधिष्ठापित होने वाले मशीन/उपकरणों के कोटेशन/टेंडर एवं डिटेल्स तथा

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कार्यान्वयन का टाईम-लाईन आदि निर्धारित किया जाए। जिला मत्स्य पदाधिकारी यह सुनिश्चित हो लेंगे कि लाभुकों द्वारा समर्पित डी० पी० आर० में उल्लेखित भूमि के संबंध में यथोचित प्रमाण दिया गया हो।

4. जिला स्तरीय समिति से अनुमोदित अन्य परियोजना प्रस्तावों की समीक्षा जिला मत्स्य पदाधिकारी द्वारा कराते हुए अगली SLAMC के विचारार्थ उपस्थापित करने का भी निदेश दिया गया। मछुआरों की समूहिक दुर्घटना बीमा योजना की अनुशंसा के क्रम में निदेश दिया गया कि सभी जिलों के DLC से यह योजना अनुशासित हो, अवश्यकतानुसार घटनोत्तर स्वीकृति भी प्राप्त की जाय।  
इस योजना का अधिकतम प्रचार प्रसार गाँवों तक किया जाय।
5. सचिव महोदय द्वारा यह भी निदेश दिया गया कि अगले वर्ष से इस योजना के कार्ययोजना के अनुमोदन (DLC की बैठक आदि) के लिए पूर्व निर्धारित "टाईम-लाईन" का अनुपालन किया जाए।
6. प्रधानमंत्री मत्स्य सम्पदा योजना के Norms (प्रावधानों) के अनुरूप प्रस्तावित योजनाओं का क्रियान्वयन किया जाना। सभी जिला मत्स्य पदाधिकारियों द्वारा सुनिश्चित किया जाएगा।
7. कार्ययोजना एवं लाभुकों के चयन के लिए जिला स्तरीय समितियाँ (DLCs) एवं संबंधित जिला मत्स्य पदाधिकारी (सदस्य सचिव) ही उत्तरदायी होंगे।
8. जहाँ लागू हो ऐसी योजनाओं में तकनीकी स्वीकृति के साथ योजना प्रावक्कलन अवश्य रहे।
9. योजना का क्रियान्वयन/सामग्रियों का क्रय आदि में पारदर्शी प्रक्रिया एवं वित्तीय नियमों का पालन हो।
10. प्रधानमंत्री मत्स्य सम्पदा योजना के अधीन निर्धारित दिशा निदेशों का अनुपालन करते हुए Beneficiary Oriented सभी योजनाओं का डी०पी०आर०, भूमि की उपलब्धता, मशीन उपकरणों के Specification सहित लाभुक स्वयं संबंधित जिला मत्स्य कार्यालय में एक निश्चित अवधि के भीतर जमा करेंगे।
11. प्रधानमंत्री मत्स्य सम्पदा योजना के निर्धारित गाईडलाईस को डी०पी०आर० का आधार बनाया जाएगा।
12. परियोजना स्थल की Geo-tagging तथा फोटोग्राफी भी करायी जाएगी।
13. मत्स्य निदेशालय में State Project Unit (SPU) का गठन एवं जिला स्तर पर, इस योजना के गाईडलाईस के अनुसार District Project Unit (DPU) का गठन की प्रक्रिया तेज की जाय एवं एक माह के अन्दर यूनिट का गठन हो जाय।
14. जिला स्तर पर मत्स्य प्रसार पदाधिकारी अथवा मत्स्य प्रसार पर्यवेक्षक प्रथम स्तरीय अनुश्रवण पदाधिकारी तथा जिला मत्स्य पदाधिकारी द्वितीय स्तरीय अनुश्रवण पदाधिकारी होंगे। सभी जिला मत्स्य पदाधिकारी परियोजनाओं की सफलता हेतु अधिकतम प्रयास करेंगे।

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15. निर्माण संबंधित परियोजनाओं के नियमित अनुश्रवण हेतु जिला स्तर पर उपायुक्त द्वारा नामित सक्षम अभियंताओं की सेवा ली जाएगी।

24. एसोसिएट डीन, मात्रियकी महाविद्यालय, गुमला द्वारा सुझाव दिया गया कि राज्य के लिये इस योजना के केन्द्रांश के कुल allocation मो 183 करोड़ रु0 का पूर्ण उपयोग करने का मत्स्य निदेशालय प्रयास करे।
25. योजनाओं के सफल क्रियान्वयन को दृष्टिपथ में रखते हुये लाभुकों को बैंकों से वित्तीय सहायता प्रदान करने हेतु अपेक्षित सहयोग प्रदान की जाए।

#### अन्यान्य :

1. वित्तीय वर्ष 2022–23 में सरकारी क्षेत्र के लिए देवघर में फिश बूड़—बैंक की अनुशंसा की गई थी तथा NFDB के माध्यम से भारत सरकार को प्रस्ताव प्रेषित था। किन्तु भारत सरकार से स्वीकृति एवं राशि प्राप्त नहीं हो सकी। इस प्रस्ताव की स्वीकृति भारत सरकार से प्राप्त करने हेतु उसे पुनर्वैधिकृत करते हुए वर्ष 2023–24 की योजना में शामिल करने का निर्णय लिया गया।

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


